SUBJECT: Case Management Services

EFFECTIVE DATE: Immediately

Effective immediately, the maximum number of authorized units for case management services has been increased from 50 units to 58 units. Each unit is a minimum of eight minutes and a maximum of 15 minutes. Active authorizations for case management will automatically be updated to reflect this change. Please refer to the authorization chart below for details.

The current caseload capacity per case manager is 25 individuals. In order for a provider to increase the caseload size to 30 individuals per case manager, the provider must have a GPRA follow-up rate of at least 80 percent. Additionally, a comprehensive chart review will be required prior to the increase in caseload size. DMHAS will conduct a chart review to determine if the ATR case management charts are in order. Specifically, DMHAS will review progress notes, releases of information, recovery plans and billing practices in order to make the decision as to whether the provider can increase the caseload size.
