ACCESS TO RECOVERY II PROGRAM (ATR II)**

ATR II PROGRAM INFORMATION

CLINICAL AND RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES AUTHORIZATIONS

In ATR II, eligible recipients are able to choose services and service providers. Service authorizations are issued as pre-approved vouchers and are available to recipients during the authorization timeframe. **Authorization maximums and timeframes are listed below for all available ATR II services.**

| Service | Initial Authorization Maximum | Authorization Timeframe | Program Authorization Maximum |

| Food | \$40 voucher | 30 days | 1 voucher |
| Clothing | \$100 voucher | 30 days | 1 voucher |
| Personal Care | \$20 voucher | 30 days | 1 voucher |
| Transportation | 30-day bus pass | 30 days | 3 bus passes |
| Independent Housing | One month's rental assistance (at HUD rate) | 1 month | One month's rental assistance (at HUD rate) |
| Education or Vocational | up to \$500 | 12 months | \$500 |
| Buprenorphine | 26 units for medication and clinical services (1 unit per week). | 6 months | 52 units |
| Case Management | 58 units | 5 months | 58 units |
| Co-Occurring IOP | 24 units | 8 weeks | 24 units |
| Co-occurring Residential | 14 units | 14 days | 30 units |
| Recovery Check-Ups | 14 units | 12 weeks | 14 units |
| Faith-Based Services | 22 units | 5 months | 22 units |
| Peer-Based Services | 44 units | 4 months | 44 units |
| Supported Recovery Housing | \$500 | 30 days | 2 months |
