John Doe is a 25 year old black male who was recently released from Bergin Correctional Facility. He is seeking ATR II services because he used marijuana and alcohol regularly before his two-year incarceration. John is wants help with recovery as well as assistance with vocational services. Based on the substance use, GPRA and mental health screen, John could benefit from a GED program, employment, and a mental health referral. John Doe expressed concern that the ATR II services not interfere with the meetings with his probation officer and requested that we report to his probation officer when he is doing well. John also expressed frustration that the mother of his three year old daughter has made it difficult for him to spend time with his daughter. Finally, John indicated that because he is so friendly he never has a problem getting a job. He says he just needs help getting an interview. At the time of intake, he seemed alert and motivated. He reports that he is not currently taking any drugs or medications. He is staying in an ATR II sober house.
